COVID SAFE Conditions of Entry 2020



By attending Condamine Bell Campdraft 2020, all attendees agree to abide by the COVIDSafe plan put in place by the ACA & the Condamine Campdraft. Any person/s who fail to comply with this plan will be made to leave the premises immediately, risk fines, and possible banning from future events. The committee reserves the right to evict any person not complying with the rules.

- > All attendees must practice social distancing at ALL times, including while on horseback, when back at their own camp etc.
- All campsites MUST be at least 15 metres apart and numbers limited to 10 people per campsite at all times.
- Competitors with their own toilet and shower facilities in their trucks/goosenecks are asked to use them instead of sports ground facilities to assist us in staying within the COVID plan.
- It is a requirement of entry that no photos or videos of the 2020 Condamine Campdraft are uploaded to any social media platforms.
- All attendees, including spectators, partners and children MUST complete a signed Condamine Bell Campdraft COVID-19 Health Screening Declaration Form (attached to this program) upon entrance into the sportsgrounds.
- On arrival, all attendees will be given a wrist band that MUST be worn for the entirety of their stay.
- > It is strongly recommended that all attendees download and use the Australian Governments COVIDSafe app while at the event.
- If you are feeling unwell in any way, DO NOT ATTEND

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OPEN DRAFT

Joyce Campbell Memorial Ladies Draft – this draft will be run in conjunction with the Condamine Bell Open 2020. The top 15 nominated Lady riders in the Open draft, at the end of Round 2, will compete in an additional final following the completion of Round 2.

PLEASE NOTE: This is NOT a points draft.

CONDITIONS

- 1. All competitors must be current 2020/2021 financial members of the ACA. Nominations will be limited and numbers are restricted to the first fully paid first round nominations received.
- 2. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
- 3. Any horse, rider or combination of, may change up until the start of the 1st round of the Open Draft. In the event of a change the secretary must be notified prior to the commencement of the 1st round.
- 4. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Men's, Old Buffers, Futurity, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- 5. Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of draft. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to Condamine Campdraft Committee.
- 6. All competitors compete at own risk.
- 7. All prize money listed is GST inclusive.
- 8. Judge's decision is final.
- 9. Refunds and prize money will be paid out by direct deposit following the event. To receive payment promptly <u>competitors are requested to ensure their current banking details are provided on Campdraft Central.</u>
- 10. Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets in the main arena.
- 11. Junior competitors under the age of 13 are not permitted to compete in any drafts other than the Junior Draft.
- 12. The committee reserves the right to change the order of the program and also close nominations and alter/delete or adjudicate on any event.
- 13. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- 14. All competitors must complete a **horse health declaration form** attached to this program, and hand to the Secretary's Office upon arrival at the Condamine Sports Grounds.
- 15. Neither the organising committee, Western Downs Council nor the ACA accept any liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to horses, riders, beast or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 16. Entry/exit restricted to the western gate off the Leichhardt Highway.
- 17. Gates will be locked at 7:00pm each night

NOMINATIONS/SCRATCHINGS

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

- 1. Nominations must be paid in full by cheque or direct deposit by 5pm Wednesday 30th September 2020
- 2. Withdrawals received after 8am Friday 2nd October will forfeit a \$15 fee.
- **3.** Withdrawals received **after** 8am Monday 5th October will forfeit the whole amount of nominations, unless extenuating circumstances apply.
