The Tambo Campdraft Assoc have a COVID-19 plan in place that all officials, volunteers, competitors, and spectators must abide by. See full details below. Please ensure you are self-sufficient with power & water.

The Judges decision is final. Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event or include other events if deemed advisable, without notice. Prizemoney paid out in accordance with rule B.5 of ACA rules. Prizemoney paid out to 6th place & will follow ACA guidelines R.8. All prizemoney & refunds will be direct deposited into bank accounts the week following the draft. All memberships must be completed by all competitors prior to drafting. Competitors ride at their own risk and the committee will not be held responsible for any horse or competitor. Any competitor under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be disqualified without recourse. Any competitor not present on 3rd call will be disqualified. Any official complaint should be made to the committee in writing within 1 hour of the event and accompanied by a fee of \$20.

ACA Terms & Conditions:

1. **AFFILIATION:** All events are ACA Affiliated.
2. **HELMETS:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
3. **SCRATCHING:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
4. **HORSE'S STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement drafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
5. **NOMINATION:** Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.
6. **ENCOURAGEMENT:** An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.
7. **FUTURITY:** The definition of a Futurity Draft is for horses four years and under.
8. **JUVENILE/JUNIOR:** Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).

Due to COVID-19 restrictions on Sporting and Community Events, we have adopted the Australian Campdraft Association Covid-19 Action Plan. To enable our event to comply with the Covid-19 regulations, please read the following rules that will be enforced throughout the weekend.

- On arrival at Caldervale, ALL competitors & attendees will be required to sign an Attendance Register and receive a wristband which will be required to be worn for the entire weekend. When you arrive, if the front gate is unattended; the sign-in register (and wristband) will be available at the Secretary's box. Replacement wristbands will also be available throughout the weekend. Please note you will not be able to compete without wearing a wristband.
- Social distancing is **COMPULSORY**. Please abide by the 1.5meter rule.
- Please remember that private gatherings at your camping area, are limited to a maximum of 50 people (if outside) with social distancing being adhered to.
- Regular hand cleaning and personal hygiene is necessary throughout the weekend. The Tambo Campdraft Committee will be supplying hand sanitiser. Please utilise this. Sanitising will also occur at the Camp gates when the front gate men are changed over, and at the Camp entry gate and Arena exit gate regularly.
- If you or any member of your camp are unwell, have travelled overseas, have visited Victoria or any of the current hotspots in the last 14 days, please **DO NOT ATTEND**.
