The Armidale Campdraft Club Inc is not registered for GST. Riders under the age of 18 years must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current AUS/NZ safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Minimum age of rider in open age events is 13 years old. All prizemoney to be paid as per ACA guidelines R6, R7, R8 and R9. Medical Services provided by St John's Ambulance. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$20 is forfeited. Horse's Status: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).

Due to the event being conducted on a showground NO Round Bales can be used. All manure to be piled up where it can easily be collected, NOT around trees or fences. Failure to do so will result in unsuccessful nominations the following year. Please DO NOT tape trees into horse yards, or tie horses to trees.
