Terms & Conditions

- 1. All drafts will be run under current ACA rules.
- 2. Riders are limited to 6 First Round Runs and horses limited to 2 first round runs excluding Junior and Juvenile
- 4. Competitors compete at their own RISK.
- 5. Judge's decision in all cases is final.
- 6. All campdrafts are to be won outright.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or adjudicate on any event.
- 8. All electrical equipment MUST have a current test tag.

9. The decision of the committee on all matters pertaining to the competition shall be final, conclusive and binding on all nominations for the events.

10. Nominate Horses in the order you wish to ride them.

11. No CHANGING of Horses or Riders 60 mins prior to the commencement of the draft.

12. If a competitor changes a nomination (horse/rider) from the original draw after the start of that event, that run may be disqualified at the committee's direction unless when extenuating circumstances apply.

13. The Fernvale Campdraft Committee does not accept responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, spectator, or any other person or property whatsoever.

14. Under no circumstances are members, under 17 years of age, permitted to ride stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.

15. All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.

16. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 MUST wear helmets at all times when mounted on a horse at all ACA competing in all events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

17. All nominations to be submitted through Campdraft Central.

If riders mistreat cattle, they may be disqualified from the entire event and riders will forfeit their nominations money and remainder of runs.

18. Once a draft has commenced, under no circumstances is any competing rider or person on horseback permitted to exit the Camp Area via the side entry gate to the Camp. All persons cracked off in the camp must exit the camp via the front camp gates. This is for the safety of all riders, horses and persons in attendance at the Fernvale Campdraft Ground.

19. The Fernvale Campdraft Committee has the right to refuse competitor's nominations - Please refer to rule D.12 of the ACA Rule Book.

20. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) then the entire nomination fee will be retained by the committee.

21. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of juniors, juveniles, ladies, mens, old buffers, associated and encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse particating.

22. The prize money as per ACA guidelines R.9

COMPLAINTS

"Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$50 is forfeited." **ENQUIRIES**
