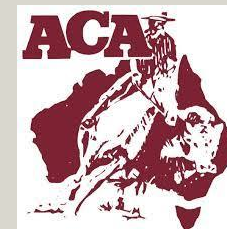

Restricted to children 8 years to under 13 years. One horse only.

Des Draper Memorial Maiden Draft \$1 200

Nomination \$40. Trophy for winner and cut out winner.

Maiden Final

Palmal Brahman's Maiden 4 Maiden \$500

Nomination \$25. Run in conjunction with the first round of the Maiden.
Separate final. Trophy for winner and cut out winner. Winner breaks horses status.

Prizemoney paid as per ACA rule R.6 R.9 used for percentages

Scratchings: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

Helmets: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACAaffiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

Covid 19 Management Plan is in place and all officials, volunteers, competitors & spectators must abide by it.

Medical Services provided by the Duaringa Ambulance Service.

Any competitor that wishes to lodge a complaint at an ACA affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing to the secretary within one hour of the incident taking place. A \$20 fee must be lodged with with complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$20 fee is forfeited.

All Stallions must be contained as per NCCA rule 11.12. Under no circumstances is anyone under 17 years of age to handle stallions within the perimeters of the grounds.

Junior Competitors under the age of 13 are not permitted to compete in any drafts other than the junior.

Run Restrictions 12 first round runs per competitor

The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time. All riders compete at their own risk and must adhere to ACA rules. Judges decision is final.

Horse Status: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).

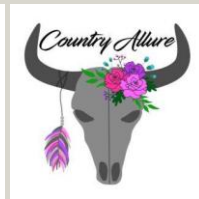
