Please note the following conditions:

1. All competitors compete at their own risk
2. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
3. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program
4. **Maximum 8 first round runs per competitor.**
5. No juniors in open aged drafts
6. Nominations will be only accepted via Campdraft Central—Only current ACA members can nominate; non-current nominations will be scratched if advised as non-current by ACA.
7. The judge's decision is FINAL in all drafts
8. Any changes done after 7am Saturday morning will incur a \$5 charge with proceeds donated to the Surat Pony Club.
9. SCRATCHINGS: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7

days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

10. Prize money paid according to ACA Rules R8 & R9

11. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.

12. Stallion Containment requirements as per NCCA Rule 11.12

13. Entry into Bar/Canteen will require QR Code scan.

14. All rubbish must be placed in bins provided prior to leaving – any campsites with rubbish left at them will not have their nominations accepted into further drafts.

15. An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 open age draft or placed 3 times in an open age campdraft.
