**FUTURITY DRAFS** are open to horses 4 years and under that have not competed outside a futurity draft. **Proof of registration** or **Vet Certificate** is required for non-recognised AQHA or ASHS horses. **ASHS Futurity Draft** horses must be ASHS registered and hold a competition 'eligible' status. Rider must also be a financial ASHS member. ASHS horses can nominate in one Futurity event only at the competitor's choice.

**PRIZE MONEY:** Rule R.6 & R.9

Under \$500 paid to 4<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup>.

\$500 to \$1000 paid to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup>.

Over \$1000 paid to 8<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons to 8<sup>th</sup>.

1 Round plus Final. Split R1 20% Final 80%

2 Rounds plus Final. Split R1 15% R2 15% Final 70%

Stallion Draft paid to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Ribbons to 3<sup>rd</sup>.

- ❖ **NO POWER ON SITE**
- ❖ The organising committee **reserves the right to change the program without notice, cancel events or apply further restrictions to first round runs** should nominations exceed cattle numbers.
- ❖ **ACA rules apply**
- ❖ Any competitor that wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated event must lodge the complaint in writing to the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20 is forfeited.
- ❖ The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of the horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Drafts. The winner attains the status of the highest-class horse participating. E.g if ONE Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft.
- ❖ At a fixture, the horses 'status' will be as at the beginning of each draft at the fixture. Rule 9.9
- ❖ **All Stallions** must be contained as per NCCA rule 11.12
- ❖ Junior riders 13 years are only able compete in the Junior Draft.
- ❖ Under no circumstances is anyone under the age of 17 years, permitted to ride/handle stallions within the parameters of the grounds.
- ❖ **Encouragement Draft:** an encouragement draft competitor shall be 17 years and over who has not won 1 encouragement or won 1 open age draft or placed 3 times in an open aged draft.
- ❖ Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events at all times. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- ❖ The committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person to compete in the Branch organized events.
- ❖ To be eligible for LOCAL events, riders must live within 200km radius of Powlathanga Station
- ❖ All dogs on the grounds must be either tied up or on leads at all times. No dogs are permitted in the spectator area.
- ❖ **ALL CHILDREN** competing in the horse sports must be financial members of the ACA. Helmets must be worn and fastened at all times whilst mounted.
- ❖ COVID-19 management plan is in place. All officials, volunteers, competitors & spectators must abide by it.
