- *All finals will be run after the event, time permitting
- *NCCA/ACA Rules apply to all campdraft events.
- *The organising Committee reserves the right to alter the programme at any time.
- *Please ensure that any horse/rider programme changes are made through the office prior to the commencement of each event.
- *Stallions must be double tied or enclosed by panels when not ridden. After dark, stallions MUST be double tied. Panels must be a min height of 1500mm and constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of a minimum width of 25mm box/pipe equivalent. Panels must be securely anchored to a solid point (i.e. truck,/post/tree).
- *As per ACA rules, under no circumstances are members less than 17 years of age permitted to ride stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.
- *Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin.
- *Dogs must be restrained at all times.
- *Entries will be restricted at the discretion of the committee
- *Showers will be available on the grounds.
- * No trees are to be included in horse yards and no horses are allowed to be tied to trees

 - The committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to the conditions of nomination as set out by the Committee. Entries may be sent back at the discretion of the committee.
 - Competitors <u>MUST BE FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE ACA</u> prior to the Gingin campdraft, <u>nominations will not be accepted without provision of an ACA member number</u>. Please note that ACA day memberships are <u>no</u> longer available.
 - Entries will not be accepted without full payment of all entry fees.
 - <u>Note:</u> Novice A and B events: no horse will run in both Novice A and B events. Competitors will enter one novice event on campdraft central and these will then be split. Competitor runs will be determined by means of a draw and placed into either the Novice A or B, in which you will compete.
 - Prize money will be split as per ACA guidelines R.7, R.9 & E.2, E.3, E.4
 - The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdraft. The winner attains the highest status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft)
 - Medical services will be provided by St Johns Ambulance.
 - Scratchings: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws between 96 hours (4 days) and 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program \$15 per horse per draft shall be withheld and the balance of the nomination fee refunded. If a competitor withdraws within 96 hours (4 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program, the entire nomination fee may be retained by the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee
 - Please note that there are <u>TWO</u> Junior and Juvenile events, each of which requires separate nomination
 - Food will be available for purchase at the food van on Friday evening and throughout the weekend
 - "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee the \$20 is forfeited".
 - Covid 19: A Covid 19 Management plan is in place. Please sign into the venue using the QR code supplied with the SafeWA app. All officials, volunteers, competitors and spectators must abide by the plan.
