Conditions:

- The committee reserves the right to alter the program or delete any event as necessary and to reject any entry at anytime, particularly as cattle numbers are limited.
- Maiden Series Event is a two round competition run in accordance with the ASHS National Rules. Horses must be a Maiden on the day after the completion of the last National Show event to qualify for entry into the maiden series
- Yards are available for a fee of \$5 per yard, first in best dressed, fees will be collected at the draft.
- Competitors must be financial members of the ASHS or ACA or pay ASHS day cover (\$45) prior to commencement of Draft.
- Approved ASNZ 3838 or ASTM F1163 helmets must be worn at all times when riding.
- Juniors (under 18) must not handle colts or stallions. All colts and stallions must be bitted.
- Prizemoney to 4th, Ribbons to 6th. Prizemoney will be paid by direct deposit into your nominated bank account.
- Scratchings - A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted.
- Changes must be submitted in writing to the Events Secretary no later than 10am Saturday, changes for the Maiden must be submitted prior to 9pm Friday night.

- COVID Restrictions apply, QR Code check is required and Covidsafe settings. Covid 19 Management Plan is in place and all officials, volunteers, competitors & spectators must abide by it.
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.
- Junior and Juvenile - Junior 8 – under 13 and Juvenile 13 – under 17.
- Medical Services will be onsite – ProMed First Aid.
