***HELMETS:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Committee reserves the right to alter any of the program and the committee's decision will be final*

***HORSE STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of juniors, juveniles, ladies, mens, old buffers, associates and encouragement camp drafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg. if one open horse competes then it is classed as an open campdraft).*

***SCRATCHINGS:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.*
