NOMINATIONS:

1. All riders restricted to eight (8) first round starts
2. Nominations via www.campdraftcentral.com.au – Open Wed 27th July 8am for 24 Hours.
3. All competitors must be ACA Members – no ACA casual memberships are available.
4. Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.
5. Nominations only processed once nominations are closed and not accepted until you have received notification.
6. Nominate in horse order.
7. **No changes** will be accepted after the draw is posted, other than scratching's.
8. Scratching's as per ACA Rule D.5.
9. No nominations accepted without payment. Full payment for nominations must be received 7 days from date of invoice. Unpaid nominations will be cancelled after this date.
10. Direct deposit to Bell Show Society Campdraft - BSB 638070, A/C 13632906. Payments without reference (Campdraft Central USERNAME/REFERENCE) will not be accepted, or alternately post to 185 Parker Road, Ellesmere 4610.
11. Horse Health Declaration, attached to the program must be completed and handed in at the Bell Secretary Box prior to competing – arm bands to be issued.
12. The Committee will manage nominations as per ACA guidelines and reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason

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CONDITIONS:

1. As the Bell Campdraft is a sport run by volunteers of the Bell Show Society, as a committee, we ask that all competitors treat all our volunteers with respect. The Bell Show Society reserves the right to refund nomination fees and ask any competitor to leave the Bell Show Grounds who is found by the committee to be behaving in an inappropriate manner towards any of our volunteers.
2. The Bell Show Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever and if required close nominations earlier, due to possible shortage of cattle
3. All events to be conducted under the rule of the ACA, Qld Chamber of Agriculture Societies and the Bell Show Society where each applies.
4. All competitors compete at their own risk. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that neither the Bell Show Society Inc nor the Western Downs Regional Council will be responsible for any injury, loss or damage.
5. **Helmets:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a Horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
6. **Scratching:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuation circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
7. **Horse Status:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes, except for Juniors, Juveniles and Encouragement Campdraft. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open Horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft)
8. **Status Breaking:** Running a status breaking event, rider and/or horse may break status.
9. **Encouragement:** An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open aged draft or placed 3 time in an Open age campdraft.
10. **Stallions:** All Stallions are to be retained in accordance with ACA Rule 11.11
11. **Junior Events:** Ages 8 years to under 13 years. Junior Campdraft are to be judged the same as Juvenile Campdraft, however with one beast in the yard and leniency shown at the judge's discretion. Juniors to compete on any status horse, except stallions.
12. **Juvenile:** Ages 13 to under 17 years. Juveniles to compete on any status horse, except stallions.
13. **Complaints:** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the Bell Show Society Campdraft Committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 (cash only) must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
14. In the case of any exotic animal disease outbreak occurring prior to or during the Campdraft, all equine animals must remain at the Bell Showgrounds and abide by the DEEDI rulings and guidelines at that time. All costs incurred are to bourn by the competitor and in no way is the Bell Show Society Inc. liable for the expenses in the case of a lock-down.

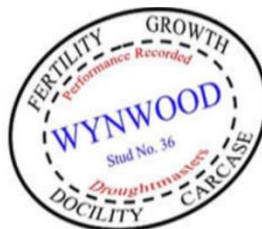
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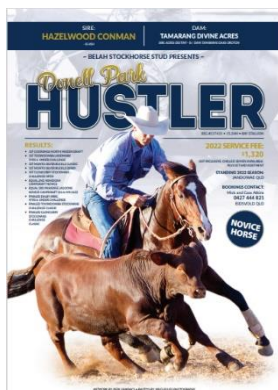

I give my authorisation for the designated Committee Member to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above, and in my care, should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this.

I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:

1. If required before movement, all horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry with hooves picked cleaned and washed.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horse/s should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Bell Campdraft.
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I agree to abide by all conditions and directions of Bell Campdraft Committee.
5. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by the Judiciary/Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of Horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their Horse/s including feeding and watering.
