CONDITIONS

- The Dalby & District Campdraft Club Inc. does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- The committee reserves the right to change the program without notice.
- All competitors compete at their own risk.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- Stallions must be restrained as per ACA Rules please read 11.12.
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buggers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft).
- To be eligible for additional prizes, all details must be provided at time of nomination.
- ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE ALLOCATED AS PER ACA RULES.
- SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- MEMBERSHIP: No ACA casual memberships are available
- The showgrounds will open on Friday morning and close on Monday evening, camping at grounds outside this time may incur a camping fee imposed by WDRC.

I,..... declare that the horse/s named above has/have been in good health, eating normally and not shown signs of illness during the last 5 days leading up to the Dalby & District Campdraft. I give my authorization for the designated Committee Member to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above and in my care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this. I agree that should my horse at any time become sick at the event I will advise the event organisers immediately.

I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:

- 1. If required before movement, all horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
- 2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Dalby & District Campdraft.
- 3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
- 4. I agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Dalby & District Campdraft Association.
- 5. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by the Judiciary/Disputes Committee.
- 6. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering.
