ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE AT OWN RISK

Medical Services Provided by Queensland Ambulance Services.

Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
Scratching must conform to ACA Guidelines D.5.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER OR DELETE ANY EVENT PRIZE MONEY AS TO ACA GUIDELINES R.9.

The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).

Complaints must be lodged in writing with the Secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.

All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
