NUTRIEN GRADUATE CAMPDRAFT

Nutrien Graduate Campdraft - \$330

- 1. The Nutrien Graduate Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Tamworth.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name. This is mandatory.
- 4. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter horses in the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft.
- 5. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the prizemoney that attaches to the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft if all the following conditions are complied with:
- The horse was purchased at a previous Nutrien Classic Sale; Willinga "Breed for the Future" Filly Sale; Nutrien Supreme; or (Northern Performance Sale, 2022 onwards) and remains owned by the original purchaser.
- The horse is 6 years old or older at the date of the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft. (NOTE: All horses will be aged based on the 1st of August each year).
- Owners may nominate any rider to compete the nominated horse/s. The same rider is to compete in all rounds of the competition.
- No horse is eligible to compete in the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft if it was sold at any of the abovementioned Nutrien Equine Sales by the vendor to a purchaser that is related to the vendor either by syndicate, company, or family.

Nutrien Nursery Campdraft - \$110

- 1. The Nutrien Nursery Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Tamworth.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name. This is mandatory.
- 4. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter horses in the Young Graduate Campdraft.
- 5. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the prizemoney that attaches to the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft if all the following conditions are complied with:
- The horse was purchased at a previous Nutrien Classic Sale; Willinga "Breed for the Future" Filly Sale; Nutrien Supreme; or (Northern Performance Sale, 2022 onwards) and remains owned by the original purchaser.
- The horse is 5 years old or younger at the date of the Nutrien Nursery Campdraft. (NOTE: All horses will be aged based on the 1st of August each year).
- Owners may nominate any rider to compete the nominated horse/s. The same rider is to compete in all rounds of the competition.
- No horse is eligible to compete in the Nutrien Nursery Campdraft if it was sold at any of the abovementioned Nutrien Equine Sales by the vendor to a purchaser that is related to the vendor either by syndicate, company, or family.

Open 4 Open Campdraft - \$220

- 1. The Open 4 Open Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Tamworth.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the Open 4 Open Campdraft if they were either vendors or purchasers at any 2022 Nutrien Equine Sale (Nutrien Classic Sale; Nutrien Supreme; or Northern Performance Sale); OR have an eligible horse in the Nutrien Graduate Campdraft or the Nutrien Nursery Campdraft.
- 4. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter horses in the Open 4 Open Campdraft.
- 5. This vendor or purchaser entity is then entitled to enter a maximum of four (4) horses. These horses must be solely owned by the entity that qualified as a vendor or purchaser at any 2022 Nutrien Equine Sale.
- 6. Horses MUST be of Open status.
- 7. A rider can ride any eligible horse; however, a rider is limited to a maximum of 4 first round runs in the Open 4 Open.
- 8. An eligible horse may be changed up until the start of the competition, providing the new horse meets the qualifying requirements for the Campdraft.
