- **Restrictions: 8 first round runs per competitor.**

- Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'.
- The Committee reserves the right to add or delete restrictions if necessary.
- The Waiver Form and the Horse Health Declaration including PIC details must be provided to the Secretary. They must be signed by all competitors prior to competing.
- Stables for hire for \$5.50 per night. See secretary for bookings and payment.
- Mundubbera Show Society Inc. is GST registered ABN: 47063281351.
- All nominations include GST and all prize money is GST inclusive.
- Campdraft events are ACA Affiliated.
- MEDICAL SERVICES provided by Country Style First Aid & QAS for the rodeo events.
- HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.
- JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years) and Mini (Under 8 years).
- Junior Cattle Working and Mini Cattle Working is restricted to one run per competitor and will be held in the Rodeo Arena. Junior & Mini competitors are only permitted to ride in the Junior Cattle Working and Mini Cattle Working.
- COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited".
- No ACA casual memberships are available.
- STALLIONS: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
- Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nominations the Mundubbera Show Society Inc. will not be responsible in respect of injury, loss or damage.
