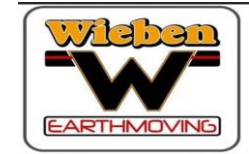

The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is then it is classed as an Open draft.

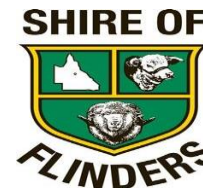
